

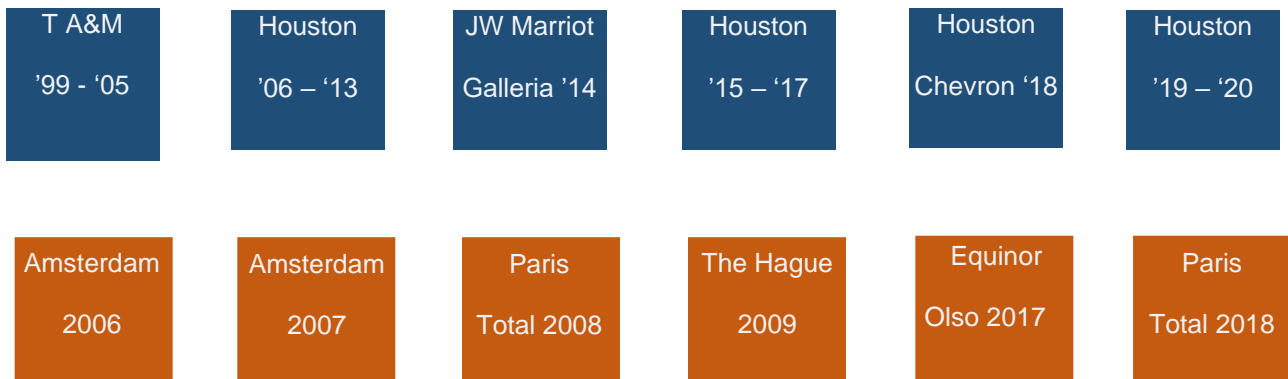


Introduction to Multiphase Pump User Roundtables

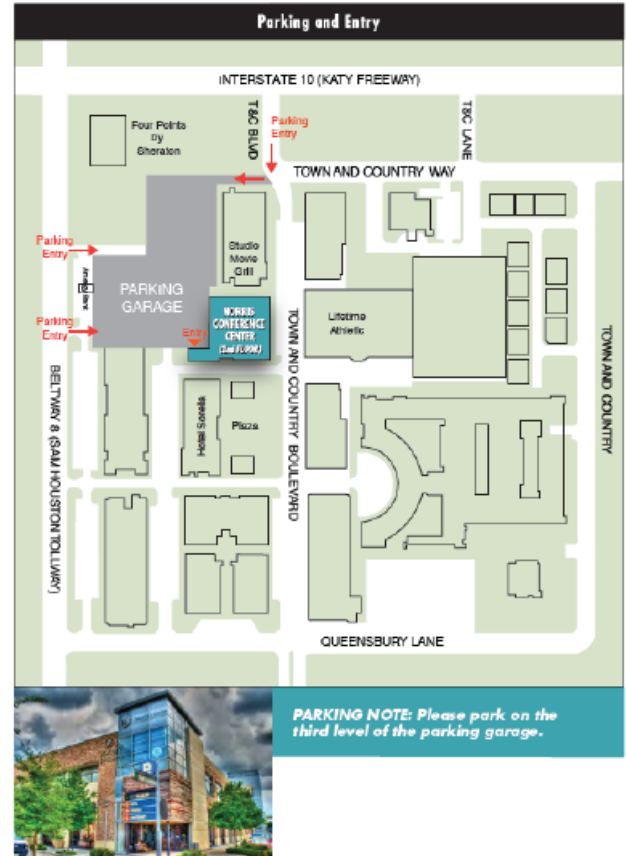
